**Summary:** The President is responsible for the overall operations of the college by initiating, guiding, and directing activities which are necessary to fulfill the mission of the White Earth Tribal & Community College. The President is responsible for providing strong capable leadership to the college by being a strategic and visionary leader who will discern, prioritize, and act on the challenges facing the college within the policies set forth by the Council of Trustees. The successful candidate will commit to creating, maintaining, assessing, and reflecting upon a learning environment where academic discipline is embedded with an Anishinaabe epistemology.

**Accountability:** The president shall work under the direction of the WETCC COT and is directly responsible to the COT. The President shall administer the college in conformity with the approved policies of the COT, rules and regulations of the appropriate accreditation body, and applicable tribal, state, and federal laws.

**Qualifications:** Ph.D., Ed.D. or other terminal degree preferred, Master's Degree required. Five years of progressively responsible experience in administration of an institution of higher education, preferably in a Tribal College setting. Current driver's license and insurance required. An individual background check will be conducted. Salary based on qualifications.
