

WETCC Learner Outcomes

Okwiinogamigwewin nitam (The Community First)

Students will recognize and act upon their responsibilities to their communities as demonstrated through self-reflection, and engagement in: outreach, service, research, and participation in community events.

Mikigaadeg wendjising (Living One's Purpose)

Students will assess their understanding of self through activities such as goal setting, creating a vision or plan, identifying mentors and/or community support to advance individual efforts, and by doing things thoroughly and in a good way.

Ogimaawin (Leadership)

Students will demonstrate leadership through respectful and effective communication in various contexts, utilizing Indigenous ways of knowing to interpret conclusions from multiple perspectives.

Aapiji naanaagadawendam zhawenim ongow omaa akiing (Holistic Perspective in a Way that Honors all Things)

Students will demonstrate their ethical responsibility to be a caretaker for the natural environment including humankind.

Mino-Bimaadiziwin (The Good Life)

Students will demonstrate the knowledge and skills to promote health and wellness grounded in the *7 Anishinaabe Values*.
