PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program is designed to build proficiency and fluency for students interested in learning the Ojibwe language (Anishinaabemowin/Ojibwemowin). Students develop the ability to use the language in a natural, intuitive way—moving beyond vocabulary and grammar to meaningful, everyday communication.

The program supports language revitalization by bringing Ojibwe back into homes, schools, and communities. It emphasizes immersion-based teaching methods, provides structured learning, and prepares students for Eminence testing. Students are equipped to use Ojibwe as a language of instruction in classroom settings and to help strengthen and sustain Anishinaabe language and culture.
