Course delivery modes:

*In Person:* Students and instructors meet physically in the same classroom on scheduled days and times as listed on the course schedule.

*Online (Asynchronous):* All course materials and activities are completed online without set meeting times. Students work independently and manage their own schedules within deadlines.

*Synchronous Online:* a course that students join live classroom meetings remotely by teleconferencing on scheduled days and times as listed on the course schedule.

*Hybrid:* A course that combines both in-person class meetings and online learning. Some instruction happens on campus on scheduled days and times as listed in the schedule, and some is completed online (either asynchronously or occasionally with scheduled virtual meetings).

*HyFlex:* A flexible format where students can choose each class session whether to attend: In-person, Live synchronous online), or Online asynchronously.

Schedule is subject to change due to enrollment and other factors. \*There is a lab fee of \$70 for art courses and \$50 for science courses. Registration will not be processed until all admissions and financial aid paperwork is completed and any holds addressed.
